

Tic Tac Toe Code



Margaret's Tomato Song

Six-year-old Margaret joined her family in a summer missions trip with their local church in Virginia. The church had been running these family missions trips for many years, and each summer they traveled to a different city to minister for a week after spending a week of preparation at the church. Their outreaches came in many forms, including serving at homeless shelters, hosting block parties in low-income neighborhoods, helping renovate homes, and more.
